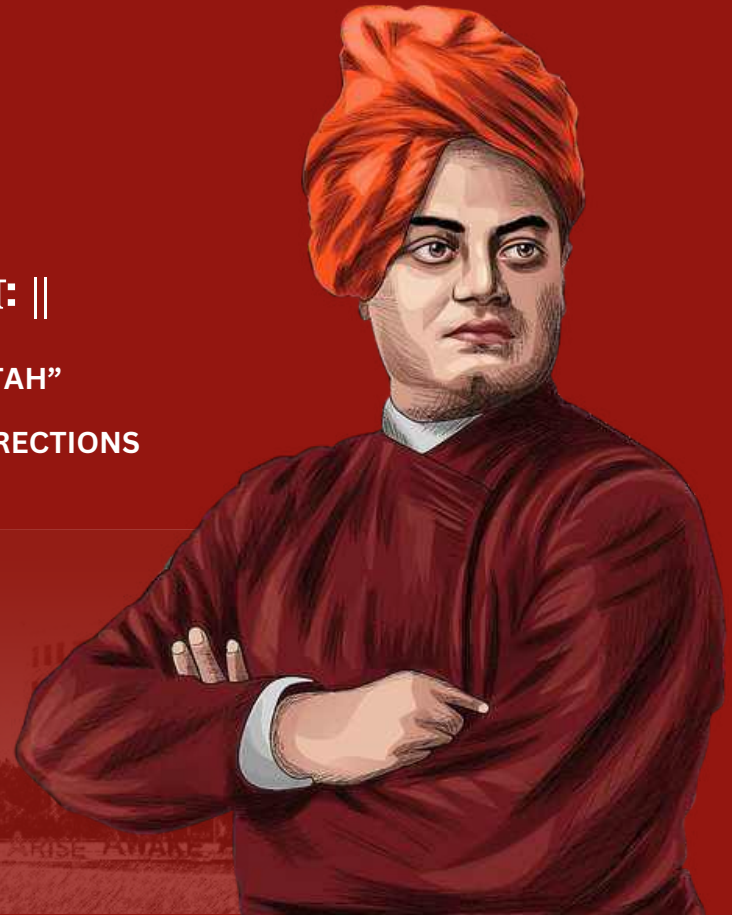



1. Hon'ble Chief Guest of today's Convocation Ceremony, other distinguished guests, Dr. K. Ram, Chief Patron of VGU, Dr. Lalit K. Panwar, Chairperson of VGU, Dr. K.R. Bagaria, Vice-Chairperson of VGU, Members of Bagaria Education Trust, Members of the Board of Management, Members of the Academic Council, faculty members & staff, guests, alumni, media persons, graduating students and their families & friends.

2. Ladies and Gentlemen; Namaskar, Good Afternoon! Today on its 7th Convocation Day, it is a matter of great privilege for Vivekananda Global University (VGU) and a profound personal honor for me to welcome the Hon'ble Chief Guest, who has been kind enough to accept our invitation to be the Chief Guest of this Convocation Ceremony and give his blessings to our graduates. Sir, we are honored and grateful to you.

3. I also welcome our Chief Patron Dr. K. Ram, Chairperson Dr. Lalit K. Panwar, Vice-Chairperson Dr. K.R. Bagaria, Members of Bagaria Education Trust, Members of the Board of Management, Members of the Academic Council, faculty members, and staff. I further extend my warm welcome to distinguished guests, alumni, and media persons. I am grateful to all of you for gracing this occasion and making it more meaningful for our students.

4. My special welcome to graduating students who have had a journey of knowledge sharing at VGU and their families and friends who encouraged, motivated, and supported them throughout their journey here.

5. Today, on this solemn occasion, I would also like to add that today's convocation ceremony is taking place on a very auspicious day; National Youth Day - the birth anniversary of Swami Vivekananda whose ideas are being followed by VGU family - Arise; Awake; and Stop not until the goal is achieved. Following Swami Vivekananda, VGU believes in providing education focusing on character building, strengthening the mind, and self-confidence, and expanding intellect in students. We believe that education is more than merely getting degrees to get employment. At VGU, we believe in education that opens a mind and is holistic. We root for women's education as we believe that when you educate a woman; you educate a generation. We believe that a society and nation that develops and prospers is one that has held no gender bias and has provided equal opportunities to all. We also take our social commitments seriously and ensure that none deserving is denied education for want of financial or unseen reasons.

6. Our graduating students it gives me special joy to address you today and celebrate your achievements. You have come a long way since your first day at VGU through your resilience to excel, hard work, and you are now ready to make your mark in the world. Congratulations.

7. Based on the verification of various academic requirements for the award of degree in 97 programs of Undergraduate, Postgraduate, and Ph.D. including 9 new programs of B.Sc. (Agri)+MBA; BBA (IB); BJMC; MJMC; MCA; M.Sc. (MLT); M.Sc. (OTT); M.Sc. (OT) and M.Sc. (RIT). The following students of various faculties are going to be awarded the degrees in today's convocation: -

(a) 161 students in the Faculty of Engineering & Technology.

(b) 24 students in the Faculty of Computer Science and Application.

(c) 65 students in the Faculty of International Trade & Commerce.

(d) 326 students in the Faculty of Management.

(e) 153 students in the Faculty of Agriculture.

(f) 16 students in the Faculty of Architecture & Planning.

(g) 32 students in the Faculty of Design.

(h) 217 students in the Faculty of Basic and Applied Sciences.

(i) 90 students in the Faculty of Law.

(j) 72 students in the Faculty of Medical Sciences.

(k) 60 students in the Faculty of Pharmaceutical Science & Nursing.

(l) 4 students in the Faculty of Hospitality.

(m) 12 students in the Faculty of Journalism, Mass Communication & Media.

(n) 20 students of Ph.D.

8. In total, 1252 students will be awarded the said degrees. Further, 92 meritorious students will be awarded with 40 Gold Medals, 27 Silver Medals, and 25 Bronze Medals. I congratulate you all.

9. Graduates, today marks an important day in your lives – a milestone achieved – it is now the beginning of an exciting journey. Graduating is an achievement and a personal accomplishment that you have attained through your individual competencies. The very fact that you have reached this stage shows that you are capable and have the strength and determination to face the unknown and succeed. I would like to say that these qualities will be important to you throughout your life. Please cultivate them to grow and find success in your future endeavors. Your education at VGU has built a solid foundation for you to succeed. You now have the potential to achieve what is necessary to meet the challenges of the future. This is a new beginning for you. I do not know exactly how the future will unfold for each of you but this much I do know with certainty that your best is yet to come as you go out into the world poised and armed with knowledge, skill, and a passion to succeed.

10. Convocation as we all know is not only for awarding degrees and medals but also to celebrate and honor the achievements of the university in the year gone by. It is an occasion which every individual of the university looks forward to and as President of VGU, I take the opportunity to apprise you all about the University and its major achievements during the last year and what we aspire to achieve in future.

The VGU

11. VGU, as I have always said, is a young forward-looking multidisciplinary State Private University established by the Act of Rajasthan State Legislature (11/2012) as specified by UGC under Section 22 of the UGC Act 1956. The University has been recognized by all the required regulatory bodies and strives to follow the norms and standards of education laid down by them. We are also a provisional member of the Association of Indian Universities (AIU).

12. The University as you can see has a lush green sustainable campus spread over 30.7 acres of land with a quality infrastructure with latest ICT, well-equipped & modern laboratories and classrooms, state of art studios, and IT enabled enriched library to name few. To further contribute towards the energy efficiency and water conservation efforts, the University campus has been reinforced with a solar energy plant with a wheeling to the grid facility and bio-gas plant.

13. VGU, living up to its name, is a truly global university with more than 7500 students from almost all the states of India and 16 other countries pursuing their education in more than 97 career-oriented programs at UG, PG, and doctorate level in faculties of Agriculture, Engineering and Technology, Computer Science and Application, Architecture and Planning, Design, Basic & Applied Sciences, International Trade & Commerce, Management, Law, Humanities and Social Sciences, Journalism & Mass Communication, Hospitality, Medical and Allied Healthcare Sciences, and Pharmacy. I am happy to inform you that university is continuously expanding its horizons and adding more programs in different disciplines. This year, we have started new programs of B.VA (Painting Contemporary Arts); M.VA (Liberal Arts); MA (Psychology); MA (Pol Sc.); M.Sc. (Digital & Cyber Forensic); PG Diploma Programmes in JMC. During the last few years, the University has grown phenomenally in all aspects including the newly admitted students' which increased from 2354 in 2022-23 to 3635 in 2023-24, registering a growth rate of more than 50%.

14. I am also happy to report that last year VGU got approval from UGC and AICTE to offer full-fledged programs of MBA, BBA, MCA, BCA, BA, MSc (Mathematics) and MA (English) in online mode and would like to mention that we have very good responses for these programs and have successfully completed the two semesters of these programs. To ensure smooth and effective delivery of education in these Programs we established the Centre for Distance and Online Education (CDOE) in October 2022 and offered three UGC-entitled online degrees in MBA, BBA, and BCA from January 2023 session with approximately 200 learners who passed their examinations with an impressive success rate of 85%. The second batch commenced in July 2023 with five operational online degree programs of MBA, BBA, MCA, BCA, MSC-Mathematics and saw a remarkable rise in enrollment with over 600 learners.

15. CDOE is committed to provide a robust academic experience through innovative academic delivery via a user-friendly Learning Management System, incorporating virtual live sessions, discussion forums, and AI-enabled assessments. CDOE has also forged collaboration with the Training and Placement Cell of the university, providing placement assistance for its learners. This strategic alliance aims to bridge the gap between education and industry, preparing learners for a seamless transition into the professional world.

16. As the first and second batches gear up for exams in January 2024, CDOE is enrolling for the January 2024 session and remains committed to high-quality education and pioneering a transformative era in virtual education.

17. It gives me immense pleasure in saying that VGU, consolidating its position as a pioneer, has effectively implemented the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 from the current academic session of 2023-24. As required by the NEP, we in VGU have developed the educational framework in lines with Curriculum and Credit Framework of UGC to ensure multidisciplinary and interdisciplinary programmes/courses with multiple entry and exit options. VGU now ensures the holistic development of students by integrating the co-curricular and extra-curricular with curricular in all the disciplines. To ensure this, our Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) took the lead and conducted various curriculum related exercises at the department level to properly align core, elective and generic courses as per requirements of NEP 2020. The detailed curriculum of all UG level programmes offered and possibility of offering Minor Degree Programmes were discussed with eminent domain/subject experts. The integration of generic and elective courses was also discussed in terms of current thrust area of market and industry demands and student's interest and credit allocation. This detailed exercise was followed by organising the Curriculum Conclave - "SAARANSH-2023" on 27-28 May 2023 in which more than 30 eminent experts of national and international repute including the former Chairman of UGC, members of regulatory bodies, subject experts and people from industry and start-ups were invited. This two-day conclave was the culmination of the 8-month-long exercise to revise the curriculum according to NEP 2020, NHEQF and NCRF. Accordingly, VGU has revised the Academic Regulations. Further, VGU has also uploaded the required data of students in Academic Bank of Credit (ABC) portal to facilitate credit accumulation of students to avail the benefits of multiple entry and exit options as per UGC guidelines. With pride I can announce that VGU stands 2nd in Rajasthan in uploading the student data on the ABC portal.

18. Now the focus of education at VGU is on application and experience-based learning with Indian values and knowledge building. Today we are a unique university where a Trans Disciplinary Project (TDP) is mandatory credit course. The focus of TDP is to ensure transdisciplinary experience-based learning leading to idea generation and startup. VGU also took the initiative to offer minor degree in 10 areas of Indian Knowledge System, Design, Economics, Psychology, Performing Arts, Sustainable Development, Environmental Science, Sports, Social & Community Engagement, and Entrepreneurship. We place immense emphasis on the capacity building of our faculty and their continuous improvement and rejuvenation. In short, I can ensure you that teaching at VGU is now more experiential, inquiry-driven, learner-centred, discussion-based, flexible and above all enjoyable.

Research, Innovation and Entrepreneurial Ecosystem

19. At VGU, we understand that education and research need to evolve and diversify continuously to match the requirements of professional and social evolution for developing a country like India and fulfil our Prime Minister's Vision of "Viksit Bharat". The university facilitates and promote research capabilities of young aspiring students and faculty members through quality infrastructure, collaborations and MOUs to facilitate projects, experiential learning, interactions with experts, and industry learning. Till date, VGU has signed 80 MoUs with reputed institutions and industry in India and abroad. VGU Alumni and NGOs have also been incredibly supportive in strengthening research and infrastructure of the University. As a result, the University has published 69 patents and design copyrights. VGU faculty members have published 347 research papers in reputed and peer reviewed journals and 36 books/book chapters during this year.

20. Along with research, VGU also encourages faculty for consultancy. Some of the major clients of the University are Indian Railways, Dedicated Freight Corridor Corporation of India Ltd. (DFCCIL), CompuCom Software Limited, Ministry of MSME, GOI, Federation of Indian Granite Stone Industry (FIGSI), Export Promotion Council of Handicrafts (EPCH) and Chhattisgarh State Renewable Energy Development Authority (CREDA) to name few. VGU has also been empanelled for training and conducting capacity building programmes of reputed agencies like Khadi and Village Industry Commission (KVIC), Jal Jeevan Mission, Bureau of Energy Efficiency, CSIR - National Environmental Engineering Research Institute (CSIR-NEERI) and also an active member of Life Sciences Sector Skill Development Council.

Entrepreneurship Activities

21. Along with research VGU understands that entrepreneurs are key drivers of economic growth and social progress of India and country needs young graduates with creative thinking to develop new products to address the challenges faced by the industry and society. To ensure this, VGU makes all efforts to ignite the entrepreneurial spirit present amongst its students thus educating India's future change makers. VGU has created a well-established innovation and entrepreneurial ecosystem in the campus which is fuelled by three dedicated incubation centres and two impactful schemes that empowers students to tackle pressing challenges with creativity and determination. These centres facilitate and mentor the ideas towards business development undertaking systematic approach for creation of enterprises including awareness camps, prototyping ideation, mentoring, and funding support.

(a) VGU-TBI, supported by the Department of Science & Technology (DST) Rajasthan, focuses on supporting rural start-ups while VGU-ACIC, supported by NITI Aayog, nurtures unserved innovations. Another VGU-TBI, supported by the Ministry of Micro, Small, and Medium Enterprises, Government of India, majorly focus on agriculture-related start-ups. In addition, VGU also has SIDBI Swavalamban Chair, which serves as an additional catalyst specifically addressing challenges encountered by Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs).

(b) VGU's systematic approach nurtures aspiring entrepreneurs. Awareness camps encourage the entrepreneurial spark while prototyping workshops transform ideas into solutions with experienced mentors providing invaluable guidance. Funding assistance connects start-ups with investors and grants, fuelling their growth.

(c) Adding to the success story, ACIC-VGU Foundation has been selected under the Start-up India Seed Fund Scheme, securing Rs. 2.00 Crore for funding startups. This scheme provides crucial financial assistance for proof of concept, prototype development, project trials, market-entry, and commercialization. ACIC-VGU has further demonstrated its commitment to its cause by disbursing Rs. 1.60 Cr. to 17 start-ups till date. Notably, four VGU-affiliated start-ups have also successfully accessed substantial funding through central government grant schemes, further contributing to the flourishing success story of these entrepreneurial endeavours.

(d) Further, to encourage entrepreneurial ecosystem, VGU has taken up initiative to integrate Entrepreneurship as part of curriculum in degree programs offered by faculties of commerce, management, design, and agriculture. The experiential learning of these students is ensured on campus through regular activities like Boot Camp, Code Red Hackathon, Prototype Competition, B-Plan Competition etc.

(e) The outcome of these initiatives and ventures are quite encouraging and have resulted in more than 90 thriving start-ups, 50+ corporate partners, 15+ academic collaborations, 40+ mentors, and 70+ events fostering learning, networking, and collaboration. It clearly indicates that VGU is not just an educational institution but also emerged as a hub for nurturing innovation and entrepreneurship, shaping a brighter India through the power of young minds. Here, the seeds of entrepreneurial spirit blossom into ventures that I am confident will reshape India's landscape, one ground-breaking idea at a time.

Following this, the club orchestrated an exhilarating industrial visit to Sitapura, unveiling the marvels of technology in the vibrant industrial landscape, sparking inspiration among attendees.
- (xix) **Cookery Club**: Indulge your inner baker at our Cookery Club's sensational baking competitions! From decadent cakes to irresistible cookies, unleash your creativity and skill. Join fellow enthusiasts in a sweet showdown, showcasing your best confectionery delights. Elevate your baking game, savour the challenge, and let your delectable creations steal the spotlight!

(e) **Panache Season 13: A Symphony of Creativity and Inclusivity.** March 2023 marked the 13th edition of Panache, VGU's annual cultural extravaganza. This three-day spectacle transformed our campus into a vibrant tapestry of artistic expression, celebrating the "Bold & Elegant" theme with dazzling performances and captivating displays. (g) **Face of VGU:** The event organised on 18 October 2023 was a triumph to spotlight the student talents across departments. Students engagement, awards, and interactive sessions enriched the experience. The event spurred talent, community unity, skill growth, motivation, and inspiration within VGU. Its success demonstrated a platform for creative expression, fostering a tighter-knit community and personal skill development. (h) Social Outreach.

(i) VGU encourages students to understand and meet social responsibilities along with their academic objectives. To ensure this, we connect our students with society through various social outreach programs which enable them to understand their roles and responsibilities towards society.

(ii) Vivekananda Social Service Society, a registered NGO, formed by students and faculty members works to serve underprivileged, promote social welfare and protect environment. The members of the society organizes regular donation drives, programs for social upliftment, and awareness sessions for the children of the nearby schools for underprivileged students.

(iii) Vivek Bharat Mandal, a student's club, conducts events to promote the ideology of Swami Vivekananda for development spiritual, mental and behavioural attributes. The club organizes various activities in nearby villages in association with the Vivekananda Kendra.

(iv) Swaruchi Kendra, is a voluntary organization formed by students residing in the campus hostel with a philosophy that literacy and awareness are key factors to secure future. The Kendra, in different ways, contributes to teaching the illiterate and motivates them to take the leap towards education. It works as a learning centre for underprivileged children living around the VGU campus. Volunteers of the centre conduct regular Art and craft, public speaking, yoga and dance activities for the children in the evening hours

(v) Various extension activities conducted by the students and faculty of the university include; voting registration of students at the University, blood donation camps, adoption of 10 villages under Unnat Bharat Abhiyan, cleanliness drive during Swachhta Pakhwada Campaign, Beti Bachhao Abhiyaan, Sarv Shiksha Abhiyaan, regular health check-up, counselling and awareness sessions for the villagers, and AIDS awareness. Placements

27. The University recognizes the value of confidence and positivity gained through employment and emphasizes on employability and future plans of its students. It also makes all efforts to facilitate preparation for higher studies, competitive exams, placements, and entrepreneurial boost to its students.

28. The Training and Placement Cell (TPC) and Institute Industry Interface Cell (IIIC) of VGU offer all possible support to students to excel in their career path. A team of faculty members and staff along with active participation of student coordinators engages in making sustained efforts to establish processes for the career development plan to facilitate the training of students for their career goals. This includes internships, opportunities for placement planning, application process, and strategic support to the students. The TPC and IIIC provide career counselling to students at regular intervals to keep them updated with the changing market scenario. TPC and IIIC also organize various activities to enhance the employability and professional skills of students.

29. As a result, this year's placements have been satisfying. More than 500 students were placed in around 150 companies at an average salary of Rs 5.50 LPA with the Highest Package of Rs 15.00 LPA at Mahindra & Mahindra. For the batch 2024, 50 Companies have provided more than 300 placements at an avg. of Rs 5.50 LPA. In the IAC-2 (Placement Week) being organized in January 2024, we expect to see at least 100 Corporates with around 1,000 placements and internships. The top recruiters this year are Mahindra & Mahindra; Larsen & Turbo; Reliance; Bajaj; Daikin; Ultratech; Adani; Tata Technology; Bosch and Amazon.

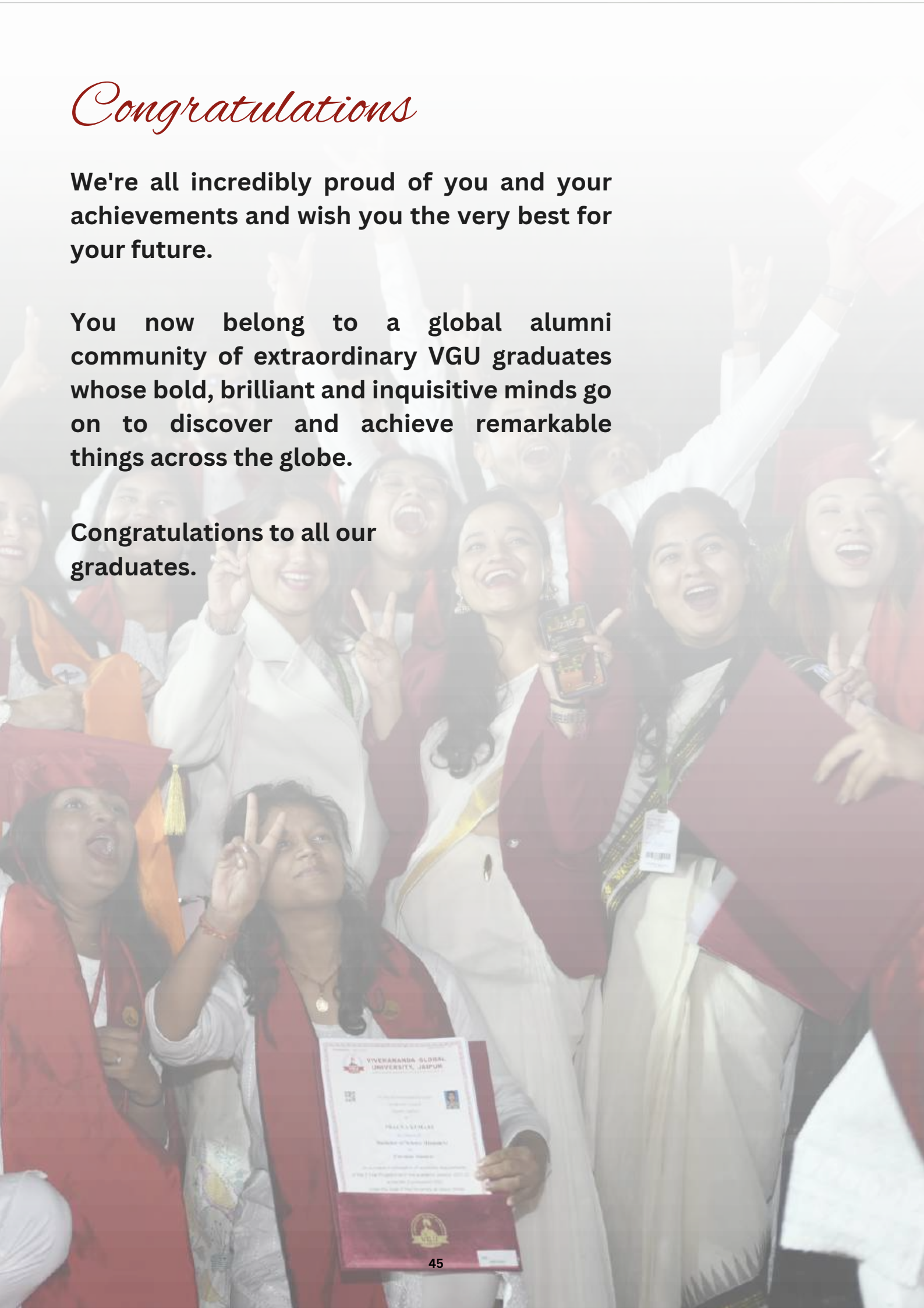
