Brief Report

Department of Law, VGU organized a two-day workshop on basics of IPR and Patents search in research. The session was attended by 40 people. Ms. Swati Sharda discussed various aspects of how the income method is the most commonly used method for IP valuation. The central thinking behind IPR is that the author must get his due, which will encourage him to keep up R&D. Some aspects of patent searching are similar to searching other kinds of technical literature. However, some aspects of searching patents are sufficiently different from searching conventional literature; a dedicated mindset, strategy and tactics need to be applied to the task. The difference between searching conventional publications and patents arise, amongst other things, from the nature of the patent documents themselves, the interrelations between them and the unique way in which patent databases are constructed.
