Discipline-specific training along with quality research publication is critical for ensuring research excellence within fields. However, training that is solely discipline-specific can affect faculties and researchers ability to be competitive for successful research careers. With little exposure to an interdisciplinary educational approach and writing skills, faculties may lack the ability to incorporate an interdisciplinary approach while writing a technical paper later on in their research careers.

Considering its pivotal role, IQAC Cell, VGU organized 15 days online training on the topic 'Techniques of Research Paper Writing' for the faculty members and research scholars of the Vivekananda Global University.

On June 2, 2021, Ms. Himanshi Singh explained why to publish research papers, followed by a session on techniques for writing a research paper. In addition, she discussed the structure of a manuscript in detail as well as formatting of manuscript according to the Journal. Then, they were given a week to reflect on the topic that interests them and share their abstract.

On June 7, 202, a session was conducted by Dr Subodh Srivastava during which information on different sources (Scopus, web of science, Science direct, etc.) from which participants could download manuscript references were given. He also discussed the structuring of the manuscript.

Another session was taken by Dr. Mohd Mukhtar Alam to discuss formatting and citation for technical writing of manuscripts. He then discussed how to select and create a researcher profile on the Journal's website.
