Brief Report

Students from ABM Department, 5 faculty members and 6 lab technicians conducted two days session on “Food Processing Industry & Schemes of MOPFI”. The aim of the session was to explicate the role of the food processing industry in agriculture and food security to help students in entrepreneurship and skill development. It also aimed to sensitize students about new technologies in the food processing industry. Students were divided into groups and each group was headed by one lab technician.

The workshop covered the following topics:

- To create modern infrastructure for food processing closer to production areas.
- To provide integrated and complete preservation infrastructure facilities from the farm gate to the consumer
