Convener welcomed all the members and briefed the members about the agenda of the meeting.

The following decisions were taken on proposed agenda :

- i. Minor revision done in list of practical in courses MAT 185, MAT 186, MAT 187, MAT 180 & MAT 181 of B.Sc. Hons. (Mathematics) and M.Sc. Mathematics were approved by the board.
- ii. The panel of External Examiners of the different courses of Mathematics for End Term Examination May 2019 was finalized.
- iii. Elective courses to be offered in even semester to students of B.Sc. (Physical Sciences), B.Sc. Hons. (Mathematics) were finalized.
- iv. Some new combinations of B.Sc. Pass course (Mathematics) were suggested :
 - Physics , Applied Statistics , Mathematics
 - Chemistry , Applied Statistics , Mathematics
- v. Combination of B.Sc. Hons. (Mathematics) with other subjects was not approved due to eligibility of Mathematics and Physics combination in many post graduate courses and job openings.
- vi. New programmes B.Sc. (Forensic Science) and B.Sc. (Military Science) were also suggested by the board.
- vii. A note sheet dated 28.07. 2018 regarding new courses of Mathematics introduced to be considered as theory in place of practical with equal credit in scheme of B.Sc. Physical Sciences (2018-2019) was presented before board and then approved.
- viii. It was recommended that the communication skills course in PG programme (M.Sc.) may be removed as it is already a compulsory paper in all UG Courses.

Thereafter , the meeting ended with Vote of Thanks to the Chair.

After necessary modification as discussed and finalized, the new syllabuses will be place before the Board of Faculty -Basic and Applied Sciences for approval.
