- 3. Teaching Scheme and detail Syllabus proposed for BAJMC (Three Year Degree Course)**

The proposed teaching scheme was reviewed by the members and found appropriate to be forwarded to Academic Council for approval.
- 4. Admission Criteria for BAJMC (Three Year Degree Course)**
For admission to BAJMC programme, a candidate should have passed Senior Secondary Examination on the pattern of 10+2 from a recognized Board of Education or an equivalent examination recognized as equivalent thereto by the University with at least 50% marks in aggregate. In case of SC/ST candidates the eligibility requirement is a minimum of 45% marks in aggregate.
- 5. Ordinance for the degree of Bachelor of Arts in Journalism & Mass Communication was proposed**
The proposed ordinance was found appropriate and approved.
