Convener welcomed all the members and briefed the members about the agenda of meeting. The committee made the following recommendations for consideration of Board of Faculty:


1. B.Sc (Hons.) Ag. students will have to secure a minimum grade point of 5.0 ($\geq 42.5\%$) to pass the individual courses and a minimum CGPA of 6 ($\geq 52.5\%$) for the degree requirement. Similarly M.Sc Ag. Programme, students will have to secure a minimum grade point of 6.0 ($\geq 52.5\%$) to pass the individual courses and a minimum CGPA of 7 ($\geq 62.5\%$) for award of the degree requirement.


A student having CGPA less than degree requirement will have to improve his/her grade in next chance. Improvement will be allowed in maximum 8 courses in case of B.Sc (Hons.) Ag. and 4 courses in case of M.Sc (Ag.) during entire duration.

2. Following course codes are recommended for RAWE programme offered in VIII Semester to B.Sc (Hons.) Ag. students.
AGR 801: RAWE training programme-18 credits
AGR 802: RAWE report and evaluation-2 credits (non-credit)
